## **Standards**

- Evaluate how organizations align with your generosity mission and vision.
- Research organizations with tools like Guidestar to review records.
- Develop a list of criteria important to you to filter groups: financial history, how/when they report, articulation of vision, etc.
- How does the organization demonstrate their ability to leverage and maximize your donation?

Financial accountability is not the only component for standards.

The purpose for standards is to advance the vision you developed. You are stewarding your vision and resources, so it is wise to invest in causes who do the same.
