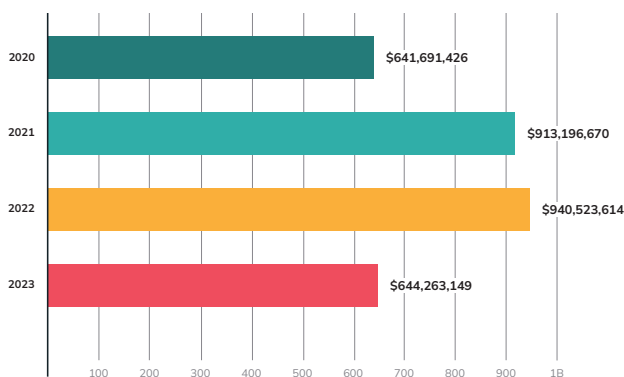
OUR COMMUNITY IN 2023

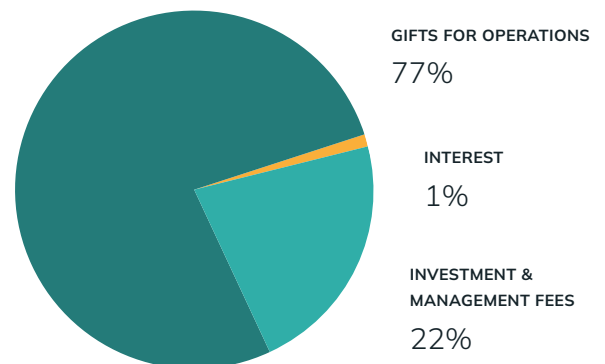
Donor advised fund contributions fuel the grants we send to nonprofits.

THE INKWELL COMMUNITY

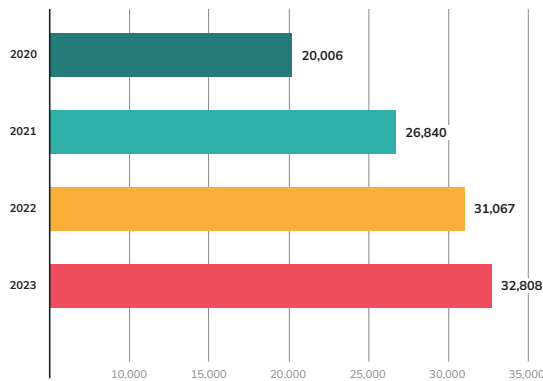

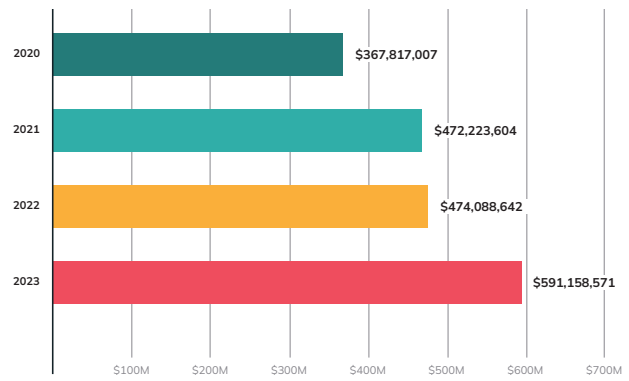
2023 operational revenue by source

GENEROSITY IN ACTION

Donors recommend grants to fuel the nonprofits working to build God's kingdom around the world. In 2023, our community sent a record number of grants to 4,978 nonprofits, 1,554 of them for the first time.

MEASURING GENEROSITY

We measure our community's generosity activation rate by comparing the dollars granted out of our DAFs in 2023 against the total dollars that could have been granted out (2022 year-end balance plus contributions made in 2023).

The Signatry's rates are calculated from our most recent 990. Average DAF sponsor rates are calculated from the most recent public IRS data: 2007 – 2020. Using the Candid method, another common generosity measurement, The Signatry's 2023 granting rate was 48.72%, compared to the industry average 12.05%.



MEET THE BAXTERS: GENEROSITY THROUGH A FAMILY BUSINESS

Richard and Tara Baxter knew they wanted to reflect radical generosity with their family dental practice. They were accustomed to giving the cash profits from their business to clean water and gospel outreach projects around the world.

“Then they discovered donor advised funds and learned about the tax benefits of donating stocks. Now, the Baxters are able to give much more by investing that income and donating the appreciated stocks to a DAF at The Signatry. The tax savings enable them to expand their family's generosity.

“The walls of their office are decorated with photos and maps showing the villages that have received clean and living water as a result of their generosity. These are powerful reminders. “We are not just doing this to fix teeth,” Richard told us. “We're doing it to help people around the world.”
