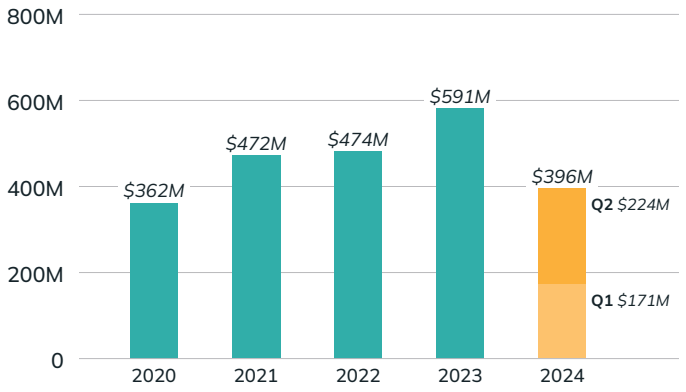

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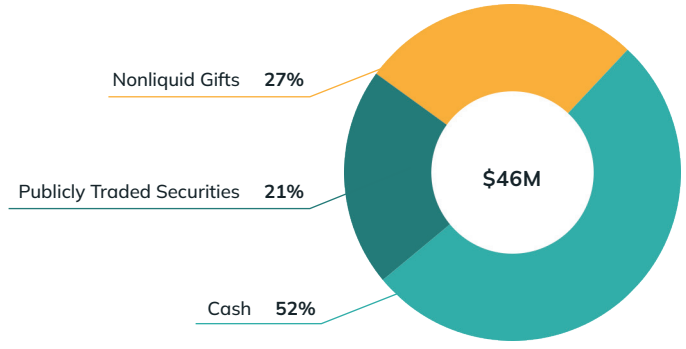

TRENDING CAUSE: Bible Teaching & Engagement

In Q2, The Signatry community recommended over 739 grants to organizations focused on Bible teaching and engagement, including 21 grants to Bible Project, a ministry based in Portland, OR, that makes free resources to help people experience the Bible as a unified story that leads to Jesus. 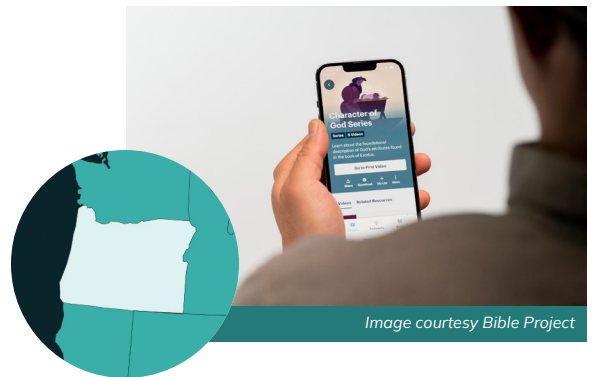

TRENDING CAUSE: Poverty Alleviation & Sustainability

The Signatry community recommended 378 grants to nonprofits working to provide sustainable solutions to poverty in Q2, including 13 grants for Unbound. Based in Kansas City, MO, Unbound works around the world, partnering with families living in poverty on their path to becoming self-sufficient and fulfilling their inherent potential.

TRENDING CAUSE: Housing & Residential Development

In Q2, The Signatry community recommended 53 grants to nonprofits tackling issues around housing security, including 17 grants for Staten Island-based Tunnels to Towers Foundation. Tunnels to Towers is a nonprofit that provides mortgage-free homes to Gold Star and fallen first responder families with young children and builds adapted homes for injured veterans and first responders.

Writing a Check **is Just the First Step**

Peter McGowan and his family share a passion to support the fight against human trafficking. This passion is shaped by Peter's own challenging past—as a young boy, when his father left the family abandoned in Vietnam, his mother made the courageous decision to get her children out of the country.

Peter realized his life could have taken a more tragic path. “If my mother had not gotten us out of Vietnam during the war, I could have been rounded up and taken to a camp, or even forced into slavery.”

Peter's story spurred the whole McGowan family to take action. They connected with Atlas Free, a nonprofit coordinating anti-trafficking efforts around the world, and began supporting this work financially.

Soon, they asked a bigger question: “How else can I get involved?”

For mother and daughter Jenn and Coryn, the answer involved participating in a 19-hour “freedom hike” to help raise more funds for Atlas Free.

For Peter, the answer involves using his professional skills to support the cause. His successful career in media and storytelling has created a large professional network of other media and technical experts. He invites friends and colleagues to share their own knowledge and expertise with Atlas Free, coaching the organization in best practices for their campaigns and projects.

“Work is the way I bring glory to God,” Peter told us. “I don't just work to make money, I work for the kingdom impact I can have. ... It's all God's—he calls us to steward what he's given us and be generous with it.”
