

TRENDING CAUSE: Global missions

In Q2, The Signatry community recommended 1,559 grants to organizations reaching the lost through global missions, including 44 grants to East-West Ministries International based in Plano, TX. East-West deploys teams of missionaries and works with national partners to start church planting movements in the spiritually darkest areas of the world.



The Signatry community recommended 826 grants to nonprofits providing Bible teaching and engagement in Q2, including 13 grants for PastorServe. Based in Monument, CO, PastorServe serves the church by serving pastors and ministry leaders with soul care, coaching, crisis support, and more.

TRENDING CAUSE: Hospitals & Clinics

In Q2, The Signatry community recommended 120 grants to hospitals and medical clinics, including 9 grants for Nashville-based Siloam Health. Siloam shares the love of Christ by serving Nashville's uninsured, underserved, and culturally marginalized through health care.









Alternative Investments as

Recyclable Impact

For most financially successful families, alternative investments are a key part of a healthy portfolio. For David and Casey Trogden, alternative investments are just as important in their generosity portfolio.

Using a donor advised fund (DAF), David and Casey partner with The Signatry to invest in private companies creating positive economic impact. Not only do these alternative investment opportunities offer the potential for growth in the DAF, they also empower charitable dollars to make a double difference: now as an investment and later as a grant.

David explained: "The idea is that, rather than sticking DAF dollars into an index fund, let's find a place to utilize that capital that's providing kingdom return now."

One of the alternative, faith-driven investments the Trogden family has pursued is in a for-profit business driving wealth creation in Uganda. The company finances motorbike taxis via a lease-to-own program that allows individuals to start their own small taxi businesses. In addition to unlocking a much higher level of income for these entrepreneurs, the company also pours into them through small groups and Bible education.

Generosity and kingdom impact will be lifelong pursuits for the Trogdens. With a family DAF at The Signatry, they have discovered even more ways to maximize their impact over time. What started as a simple charitable gift can transform into a vision-aligned alternative investment, generate growth in the fund, and be sent out to nonprofits to create additional, eternal impact.
